The Webelos Coyote Trail Xtreme (WCTX) Camp Program is a specialty Adventure Camp Weekend Program for Webelos, offered in the fall. It's all about the Webelos at this camp. The name of the game is FUN, EXCITEMENT and ADVENTURE!

During WCTX, Webelos will work on more advanced Webelos requirements and will be introduced to the patrol method giving them a unique experience into the importance of team work and other skills they will need on their first Boy Scout campout such as fire lays, (knots-ropes), basic lashings, flag etiquette, nature, first aid and more. WCTX begins on Friday evening and runs through Sunday. Space is very limited, so register early! The Leadership requirements and the Arrival and Departure procedures are the same as the Adventure Camps. Siblings are not allowed. Scout registration includes 3 meals on Saturday (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner), and Sunday Breakfast, activity supplies, t-shirt for Scouts, patch, and water bottle. Adult registration includes meals. Campers must supply their own tents and cots. A staff member in each area will provide program supplies and lead the activities. A Webelos leader may be responsible for no more than one additional "nonfamily member" youth. Packs, Webelos Dens and individual families may register.

Cost: Webelos \$115 and Adults \$40.

**Adults** must also bring copy of Youth Protection Training certificate (taken online at [www.myscouting.org](http://www.myscouting.org) within last 2 years); one adult per reservation must have Hazardous Weather Training certificate (taken online within last two years).
