Summer Resident Camp is a three-night campout for Scouts entering 1st – 5th grade for the 2017-2018 school year at Bovay Scout Ranch near Navasota. Scouts will have the opportunity to participate in activities such as BB guns, archery, sling shots, crafts, sports, games, campfire, and lots more. Advancements and adventures will supplement those offered at day camp. Scout registration fee includes activities supplies, t-shirt, patch and eight meals (dinner on day one, three meals on days two and three, and breakfast on day four). The adult registration fee includes meals. Vegetarian meals or turkey substitutions are available, but must be requested 30 days in advance. •

Bring: All attendees must bring a BSA Health and Medical Record (Parts A & B for all Scouting events) (www.scouting.org/sitecore/content/home/healthandsafety/ahmr.aspx). Refer to the Leader’s Guide at www.shac.org/resident-camp for a detailed list of items to bring.

- Adults:** Every adult must:
- 1) Submit a Camp Compliance Form by May 1st
 - 2) Bring a Sexual Offender database check (https://records.txdps.state.tx.us/DPS_WEB/SorNew/index.aspx; search using first name, last name and date of birth, then print.
 - 3) Bring a copy of Classroom Facilitated Youth Protection Training (YPT) certificate. Find courses near you at www.shac.org/training-schedule#ypt or take it at camp upon arrival. Online YPT does not count. Classroom Facilitated YPT expires every two years.
 - 4) One adult per pack must have a Hazardous Weather Training certificate taken online at www.my.scouting.org within the last two years.
