## Duck, Duck, Goose

**Materials:** None

This is a common game that most Cub Scouts should know.

All Cub Scouts sit in a circle – except for one person who is “it”. “It” walks around the outside of the circle, tapping each individual on the head and saying "duck." Eventually, “it” taps a person and says "goose" (instead of duck) and the person that’s been called “goose” has to jump up and chase “it” around the outside of the circle, trying to tag “it.” “It” has to try to run around the circle and sit in the place where the “goose” was sitting – before being tagged by the “goose”.



Continue the game until everyone has a chance to be “it” or until it is time to do something else.

## **Honesty Opening**

Lead the following discussion with the Cub Scouts:

***Our Core Value for the month of August is “Honesty”.***

***Who can tell me what they think “Honesty” means?***

[Cub Scouts probably have an idea of what “Honesty” means. Integrate as many of their answers as possible while you make sure that they understand that **Honesty means telling the truth and being worthy of trust.**

***How can a Cub Scout have honesty?***

[Listen to their responses and remind them to realize that they choose to be honest in many situations – in games, at school, in answering questions, etc – and that it’s not easy to be honest. Standing up for what is right by telling the truth can be difficult if you are honest when others are not being honest. If you need to, give some examples or stories of people who are honest.

***Let’s have a great day in Cub Scouting today.***



# Jumping Frog Origami

## Materials:

4x6 index card (1 per Cub Scout)

Pencil, marker or crayon for drawing eyes




## Directions:

*For each of the folds, make sure you crease them well.*

1. Fold down right top corner. Unfold.
2. Fold down left top corner. Unfold.
3. Fold backward as shown by dotted line. Unfold.
4. Push down at the center of "X" and bring sides to meet in the middle.
5. Push down top triangle.
6. Fold up two points of the top triangle.
7. Fold sides of card to the center.
8. Bring the bottom edge up almost to the top and fold.
9. Fold down top layer.
10. Turn the frog over. You may want to draw eyes.

Stroke the back of frog to make him jump.




## Animal Tag

**Materials:**

**Directions:**

Have the players in a scattered formation. Select one Cub Scout to be "it." "It" names an animal, and all the players assume the identity of the animal as they move around. "It" also assumes the identity of the animal he named as he tries to tag one of the animals, who then becomes "it."



**Example:** "It" calls "Kangaroo!" and everyone must hop like kangaroos until someone is tagged and person who was tagged chooses a different animal.
