Human Tic-Tac-Toe

Materials:

9 Chairs OR

Masking tape to mark 3 rows of 3 spots on the floor

Instructions:

1. Divide the Cub Scouts up into teams of 5 people.


Designate a team captain.

2. Set up three rows of three chairs each or put small pieces of masking tape on to the floor to form the tic-tac-toe grid. Depending on how many teams you have, you may need more than just one tic tac toe grid.

3. Each team decides on their team designation, e.g., hands on head for one team and hands across the chest for the other (Xs and Os).

4. The team captains then play tic-tac-toe the usual way, using humans as the Xs and Os.

If your group is too small to have five people per side, divide the team in half and use a specified marker for each team in place of the people markers.



Stand Up Game

Materials:

None

Directions:

This game is played with pairs of Cub Scouts.

1. Have each Cub Scout get a buddy.
2. The buddies sit back to back with legs stretched out in front of them.
3. The buddies must try to stand up without using their arms.

The Cub Scouts will see that they can only stand up if they work together.

Variation:

You could first let the Cub Scouts use their arms to get up from the same position and then make the game more challenging by having them not use their arms.

Buddies Closing

Cubmaster:
