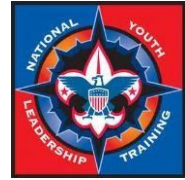




Scouter/Scout Scholarship Application

Scholarship Application Process

1. Sign up for desired course (NYLT or Wood Badge) session in Double Knot.
2. Choose “Send in Payment” option at checkout.
3. Send completed scholarship application form to the SHAC Council either by email (preferred) to Nathan.Doherty@scouting.org or Jeanne.Gebo@scouting.org , by fax at 713-865-9199 or via mail to Sam Houston Area Council, 2225 N. Loop West, Houston, TX 77008
4. Once the application is received at the council, it will be forwarded to the Baden-Powell Scholarship committee for approval.
5. The volunteer committee usually responds within two business days. If the committee needs additional information, you will be contacted directly by one of the volunteers on the committee.
6. Once a decision has been made, you will be notified by email from Support Services.
